To accomplish this, we:

- Build a just and interdependent safety culture
- Lead by example and provide resources to manage health and safety risks to As Low As Reasonably Practicable (ALARP)
- Identify and assess the health and safety hazards associated with our activities, and implement appropriate safeguards
- Enforce and verify compliance with applicable regulations and our management system requirements
- Set and monitor objectives for improving our health and safety performance
- Consider safety as a personal responsibility and Stop Work Authority as an obligation whenever an activity is perceived unsafe
- Employ competent personnel in their roles who are aware of the health and safety hazards of their work and know how to mitigate the risks
- Engage our employees in health and safety matters
- Integrate human factor principles into our health and safety management systems and processes
- Verify the effectiveness of our emergency response plans
- Learn by conducting self-verification and performance monitoring activities
- Identify the root causes of incidents and non-conformities, apply measures to prevent reoccurrence and continuously improve our health and safety management processes



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
