Pusan – Qingdao – Ningbo – Shanghai – Da Chan Bay – Cai Mep – Colombo – Haifa – Ashdod – Mersin – Derince – Istanbul – Da Chan Bay – Xiamen – Pusan

ZMP New route positions ZIM as the only major carrier to offer a direct call from Vietnam, one of Southeast Asia's fastest-growing economies, to the East Mediterranean. Customers will benefit from competitive transit times and a reliable, committed service from ZIM.
