These programs provide small US-based businesses, global artisans, national animal shelters, and farmers across the country exposure to consumers on Overstock's website.

To date, Overstock's Workstock program has returned over \$115 million to artisans and their representatives to help increase economic stability in these developing regions. The online retailer also gives back from Workstock sales to help increase education and skilled labor opportunities in the artisan's local communities.

Most recently, Overstock has partnered with Give Back Box to provide pre-paid labels allowing customers to re-use boxes from their Overstock orders to ship gently used household items to non-profit organizations.
