### **Change of Auditor**

We previously announced that, following a competitive audit tender process, we intended to appoint Deloitte LLP ("Deloitte") as the Company's auditor in place of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP ("PwC").

As explained in the Notice of Annual General Meeting published on 12 January 2026, PwC was to conduct the audit procedures required for the annual renewal of the Company's Euro Medium Term Note ("EMTN") Programme to support the submission of an audited annual prospectus to the London Stock Exchange. PwC concluded this work in early February 2026, and we received notice of PwC's resignation as our auditor with effect from 27 February 2026. Deloitte has been appointed as auditor to fill the resulting casual vacancy.

In accordance with section 519 of the Companies Act 2006 (the "Act"), PwC has provided a statement of the circumstances connected with its ceasing to hold office ("the Statement"). As required by section 520(2) of the Act, the Company is sending a copy of the Statement to all shareholders for information only.

A copy of PwC's Statement is enclosed.

**Statement of Reasons connected with ceasing to hold office as Auditors**

In accordance with Section 519 of the Companies Act 2006 (the "Act"), we set out below the reasons connected with PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, registered auditor number C001004062, ceasing to hold office as auditors of easyJet Plc, registered no: 03959649 (the "Company") effective from 27 February 2026.

The reason we are ceasing to hold office is that the Company undertook a competitive tender process for the position of statutory auditor and we mutually agreed with the Audit Committee not to participate due to the duration of our tenure.

Section 519(3A) of the Act, requires that "Where there are matters connected with an auditor's ceasing to hold office that the auditor considers need to be brought to the attention of members or creditors of the company, the statement under this section must include details of those matters." We do not consider there to be any such matters.
