

SOUND POINT ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: November 26, 2025

This Online Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy”) describes how Sound Point Capital Management, LP (“Sound Point Capital”) and our affiliated entities (collectively, “Sound Point”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) may collect, use, and disclose personal information that we collect through our websites, soundpointcap.com, cre.soundpointcap.com, usdl.soundpointcap.com and soundpointmeridiancap.com (collectively, the “Sites”). By visiting or submitting information on the Sites, you acknowledge that you accept the practices and policies outlined in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, please do not use the Sites.

U.S. investors and other financial services clients, customers, and potential clients should review [Sound Point’s Financial Privacy Notice](#), which governs how we collect, use and share your nonpublic personal information while delivering financial products or services to you.

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We may collect the following types of personal information directly from you, automatically when you visit our Sites, or from our service providers or third parties, depending on how you interact with us:

- Contact information, including your name, e-mail address, phone number, fax number, and postal address;
- Account information, including your login and password;
- Communications with us, including information you provide to us in e-mail or through online forms; and
- Internet or other electronic network activity information, including IP address, online identifier, browsing history, search history, information on a consumer's interaction with our Sites, application logs, device data and registration, social media account information or advertisement, your usage preferences, referring links from websites or advertisements that refer you to our Sites, and information collected from Cookies and other tracking technologies.

We may combine certain personal information we collect about you with other personal information we obtain about you, which may include data we obtain from other sources.

HOW WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use your personal information to:

- Provide services to you, including fulfilling requests related to your personal information.
- Manage online account records and access.
- Facilitate communications with you, including notifying you of features or special events, providing information about our products and services and our business partners services, inviting you to participate in our events or surveys, and providing you with other information we feel may be of interest to you.
- Provide access to, customize, analyze, adjust, secure and improve the Sites.
- Prevent, investigate, identify, or otherwise take action regarding suspected or actual fraudulent or illegal activity, or any activity that violates or may violate applicable laws, regulations, or legal process and our policies.
- Comply with applicable laws, regulations, or legal processes, as well as industry standards and our company policies.
- Evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets in which personal information held by us is among the assets transferred.

No mobile phone information will be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. Text messaging originator opt-in data and consent will not be shared with any third parties.

HOW WE DISCLOSE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may disclose personal information we obtain through the Sites to:

- Our affiliates, including our subsidiaries and strategic business partners, who may use your information for purposes similar to the purposes for which we collect such information.
- Service providers and contractors that we retain to perform services on our behalf, including financial service providers, such as administrators, placement agents and prime brokers, who assist Sound Point as part of the ordinary course of servicing investment; marketing companies; customer support specialists; web hosting companies; fulfillment companies, such as companies that coordinate mailings; data analysis firms; and e-mail service providers.
- Professional advisers, including counsel, accountants and auditors, and persons acting in a fiduciary or representative capacity, such as an IRA custodian or trustee.
- Third parties if we believe disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request and enforce our agreements and policies.
- Service providers, contractors, and third parties to protect the security or integrity of the Sites or our services and products; to protect ourselves, our customers, or the public from harm or illegal activities; or to respond to an emergency which we believe in good faith requires us to disclose data to assist in preventing a death or serious bodily injury.
- Third parties in connection with a sale, merger, liquidation, dissolution, or sale or transfer of any portion of the assets of Sound Point, including negotiations of such transaction.

COOKIES AND TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

We, and vendors acting on our behalf, may use cookies and other types of tracking technologies (collectively “Cookies”) on our Sites to collect and analyze information about interactions with the Sites. Cookies may serve several purposes, including storing information to help the Sites function properly, recognize your device when you visit our Sites again, and help us understand your use of our Sites over time. We, and our vendors, may link the information collected by Cookies to other information collected about you.

We may use Cookies to:

- Help you access and navigate the Sites more efficiently and to statistically monitor how many people are using the Sites.
- Recognize your login information and preferences, so that you do not need to enter the information each time you visit our Sites.

SITE VISITORS FROM OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES
