Agrilink Foods Completes Sale of Adams Peanut Butter to J.M. Smucker

Smucker Company (NYSE: SJMA and SJMB), Orrville, Ohio, today announced that they have completed the sale of the Adams brand peanut butter business to Smucker.

Adams natural and no-stir peanut butters are marketed principally in the northwestern part of the United States and in western Canada. Terms of the transaction were not announced.
